

1. Groups

- 1.1. Presently the groups are: Attracting wildlife, Bees, Composting, Container Gardening, Design, Greenhouses/Coldframes/Polytunnels, Growing and using Herbs, Growing Fruit, Growing Vegetables, House Plants, Recipes, Savvy Savers and Water Gardens.
- 1.2. They are open for all to join without an invite having to be “approved”
- 1.3. “Join Group” button, to add yourself as a member of the group
- 1.4. “Leave group” button, to leave!
- 1.5. Viewing a group page. When you click on a group and go to its page, you will see the “home page” for that group. This shows the group Avatar, name of the group, and a brief description of what it is for.

- 1.1. Underneath that you will find the various group “tabs”. These are: Home (for general news about the group), Forums (Where different group topics can be added and commented on by everyone), Gallery (A group gallery, for images specific to the group), Members (A list of the group’s members), Send Invites, (So that you can alert a member to a specific group).

2. To add a new topic for the group to discuss, click on the “forums” tab.

2.1. This will show you all the latest topics and below them an area for you to add a new topic.
